



Announcement of KhannaYao Police Station

Subject: Intention to Refrain from Accepting Any Kind of Gifts or Gratuities from Performing Duties (No Gift Policy) Fiscal Year 2026

KhannaYao Police Station is determined to enhance operational transparency, prioritize public interest over private benefit, and ensure the absence of conflicts of interest. This policy is consistent with the public sector development policy and aims to achieve the objectives outlined in the Master Plan under the National Strategy, Issue 21: Anti-Corruption and Misconduct (2023–2037) (revised edition). The goal is to ensure that all government agencies perform their duties transparently and without conflicts of interest. Therefore, all government officials shall strictly refrain from accepting any kind of gifts or gratuities arising from the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy).

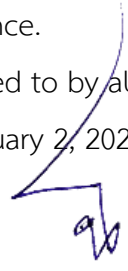
Therefore, in order to fulfill this intent and uphold the ethical standards of KhannaYao Police Station, we hereby declare the commitment of the Superintendent of KhannaYao Police Station, as well as all police officers, to refrain from accepting any kind of gifts or gratuities from the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy), whether before, during, or after the performance of duties. All personnel shall also strictly adhere to the Notification of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on the Provisions of the Acceptance of Property or Any Other Benefits on an Ethical Basis by State Officials B.E. 2563 (2020).

This commitment aims to collectively foster an organizational culture and values of integrity in the performance of duties while rejecting patronage systems. We shall avoid any actions that may influence discretionary judgment or decision-making in the discharge of responsibilities, which could lead to discrimination or unfair practices. Furthermore, we are dedicated to preventing conflicts of interest and strengthening public trust by performing our duties in accordance with the principles of good governance.

It is hereby announced and shall be strictly adhered to by all personnel.
